### **About Us**

The Chicago Palestine Film Festival (CPFF) is a non-profit organization based in Chicago that exhibits and promotes films by Palestinian directors and films about Palestine. CPFF is dedicated to presenting a film festival that is open, critical, and reflective of the culture, experience and vision of the filmmakers.

Founded in 2001, the Chicago Palestine Film Festival is the world's longest consecutive running festival of its kind. To date, CPFF has screened well over 300 independent films in Chicago. Such films address various aspects of Palestinian society, art, culture and humanity. The majority of these films have served as foundations for further discussion on socio-cultural norms in Palestinian communities here and abroad. By using film in this sense, each producer and director is given the space to directly address various political, economic, linguistic and social challenges they face to a large audience. This outlet fosters a vast dissemination of information whereby the experiences of these communities are able to transcend ambiguous national boundaries and be shared by audience members in Chicago.

### Key of Return Sponsorship Level



مفتاح العودة

The Key of Return is the Palestinian symbol of homes lost in the Nakba, when more than half of the population of Palestine was either expelled or fled Zionist violence in 1948 and were subsequently denied the right to return. Over 75 years later, the key remains a potent symbol of physical and emotional loss and injustice, as well as a steadfast hope to return.

### Olive Tree Sponsorship Level



شجرة الزيتون

Olive trees are a symbol for Palestinian identity, with their roots representing ties to the land and their branches forced displacement from it. The olive tree has become a potent emblem of Palestinian resistance and resilience, and a desire for peace.

Cultivation of these trees, integral to Palestinian culture and economy, are frequently targeted by the Israeli occupation.

### Kuffiyeh Sponsorship Level



الكوفية

Originally worn by farmers to protect themselves from the weather, the Kuffiyeh was popularized during the 1960s through the Palestinian resistance movement. The pattern represents fish nets, symbolizing the connection to the Mediterranean Sea; olive leaves, symbolizing resilience and perseverance; and bold lines, representing trade routes and rich history of cultural exchange.

### Watermelon Sponsorship Level



البطيخ

The use of the watermelon as a Palestinian symbol first emerged after the Six-Day War in 1967, when the Israeli government made public displays of the Palestinian flag a criminal offense in Gaza and the West Bank. To circumvent the ban, Palestinians began using the watermelon because, when cut open, the fruit bears the national colors of the Palestinian flag—red, black, white, and green.

### Jaffa Orange Sponsorship Level

Jaffa oranges, known for their sweetness and thick, easy-to-peel skin, were well-suited for shipping and became an important export for Palestinian farmers and businessmen. Because of their prominence, the oranges also became a symbol of national identity in literature and art. These trees were carefully nurtured over a long period of time, exemplifying the strong connection between Palestinian farmers and the land, which many were forced to forsake during the Nakba.
